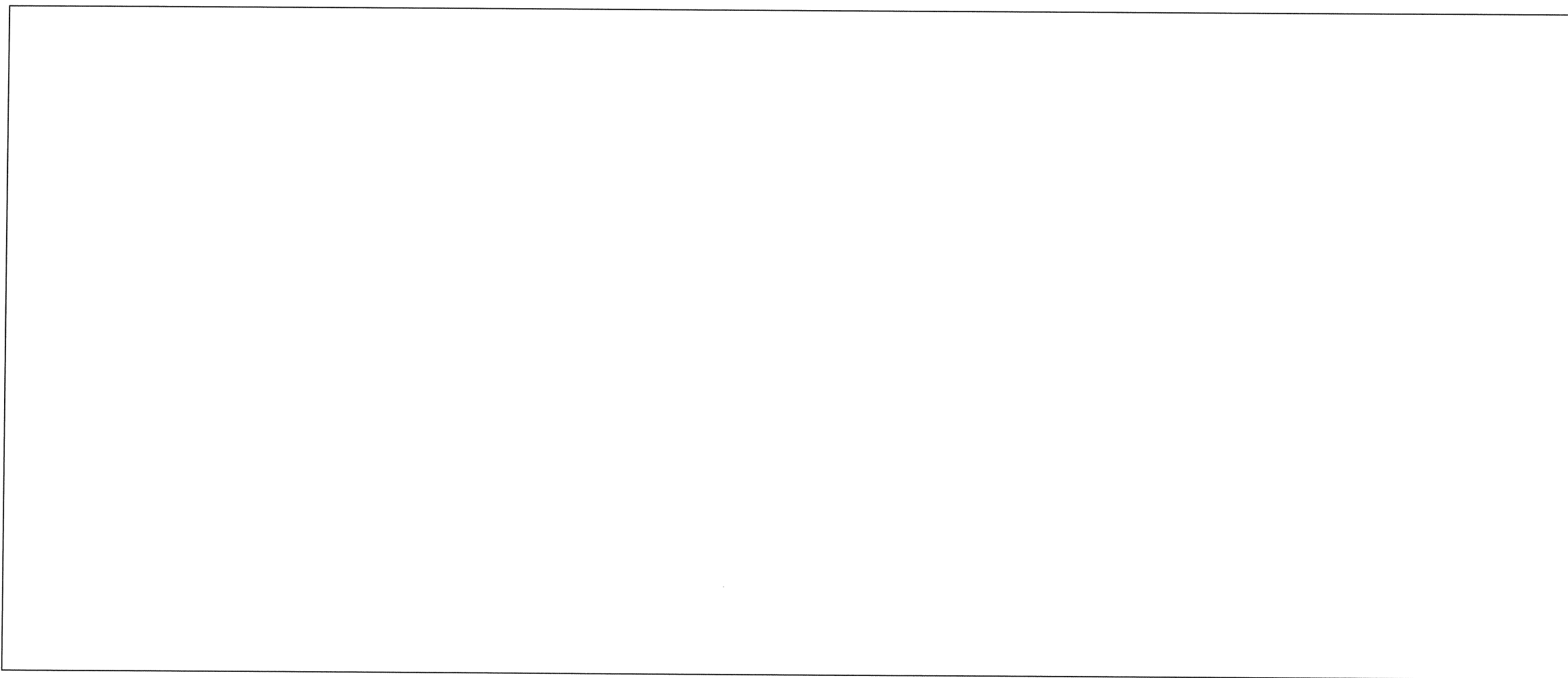


Look for the following on the gravestones:
