The Kamloops-Shuswap Peace Council is an organization dedicated to world peace and disarmament. We are affiliated to the B.C. Peace Council, the Canadian Peace Congress, the Canadian Peace Alliance, and the World Peace Council, which has members in virtually every country in the world.

On the local level, we have been successful in organizing the April "Walk for Peace", Hiroshima/Nagasaki Vigils, Cruise missile demonstrations, Tools for Peace to help the people of Nicaragua, the Anti-war Toy Campaign, and this year, we will be hosting a group of Montreal teenagers (SAGE), who are currently touring the country to talk to other teenagers about nuclear war and what they can do to prevent it.
