Petition for the Declaration of British Columbia as a Nuclear Weapons Free Zone

To Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, in Legislature Assembled:

The petition of the undersigned, Municipalities of the Province of British Columbia, states that:

- WHEREAS The nuclear arms race threatens the lives of the people of this municipality, the Province of British Columbia, and of every person on Earth; and
- WHEREAS The people of British Columbia have expressed their deep concern about the continuing buildup of nuclear weapons by establishing nuclear weapons free zones in 45 municipalities, representing over half the population of British Columbia; and
- WHEREAS The United Nations has stated that "the process of establishing (nuclear weapons free) zones should be encouraged with the ultimate objective of achieving a world free of nuclear weapons"; and
- WHEREAS The British Columbia Legislative Assembly, in 1984, unanimously approved a motion introduced by the Government saying:

"This assembly, recognizing the horrors of nuclear war and holocaust, urges all world governments to increase their efforts to end the nuclear arms race and to reduce and finally eliminate all nuclear weaponry."

THEREFORE Your petitioners respectfully request that the Honourable House declare British Columbia a Nuclear Weapons Free Zone.
