

WOMEN DEMAND PEACE FOR THE WORLD

The situation at Greenham Common is desperate and urgent:

Where there used to be 8 or 9 flourishing peace camps, there are now only 6, with a handful of tired and desperate women in each. After the cold and wet weather during winter and summer and frequent evictions, they need help now. They do not need gifts of food, etc., as badly as they need people to go to stay there for long or short periods. Otherwise in a matter of weeks the camps will be no more.

This chain letter (please don't groan - this one is different and it's in the best cause in the world) is a special project. It is to be recorded in the Guinness Book of Records and monitored by the British Post Office, who should be handling thousands of cards bearing the words: WOMEN DEMAND PEACE FOR THE WORLD.

Please send two postcards bearing these words and signed by yourself-- one to the first woman on the list below and the other to the British Prime Minister, Margaret Thatcher at 10 Downing Street, London, SW1

Please send a copy of this letter to 6 women friends or groups within 4 days of receiving this letter to keep the chain from being broken.
