Cariboo Regional College has taken further steps toward opening in September 1970.. Mr. Dave Summers of Kamloops has been re-elected Chairman of the College Council, Mr. Les Redford, General Manager Brynor Mines, Vice Chairman, Mr. Jack Harrison, Principal, has issued the Calendar containing courses and information concerning the College. With the consent of the Board of School Trustees Dist. 27, Mr. Leo Perra, Continuing Education Director has been appointed Co-ordinator of the Williams Lake Campus. Mr. Perra will appear at Columneetza and 100 Mile Secondary to make a survey of the student's ~~in~~ interests and needs. Students on the total Academic, Technical or Vocational Programmes will go to the Kamloops Campus. It is the aim of the Cariboo College Council and Mr. Harrison that individual courses be established on the Williams Lake Campus using either Columneetza and/ or 100 Mile schools, next September. Both the Academic and the Technical programmes will be acceptable at either the universities or B.C. Technical Institute. The extent of the Williams Lake Campus depends upon the total demand which the survey conducted by Mr. Perra will indicate
