Waskom Talk

Dr. John Waskom, Professor of Geology at Northwestern State University in Louisiana and internationally recognized authority in the field of Earth Sciences, will be speaking on "Creative Cycles: Cosmic Design in Man's World" at a public meeting to be held Wednesday, July 28, at 8 p.m. in the Boardroom at Cariboo College.

Dr. Waskom, in his lectures throughout North America, and most recently Vancouver, Victoria and Port Alberni, considers how man, in his present experience, can change the chaos of his personal world into something closer to the harmony which is evidenced throughout the cosmos in which he lives, by working with, not against, the creative pulsations and cycles in his environment.

Through a discussion of these creative cycles, the magic of numbers and number sequences such as the Golden Section, and what he calls the truth of design, Dr. Waskom brings such cosmic designs as the spiral, which we see in our galazy and the pattern of our solar system, down into the simple everyday patterns found in pinecones, sea shells, and the way water drains out of a bathtub.

Dr. Waskom brings to focus the perspective of a true scientist with a keen awareness of life, and speaks with the authority of a man who has already proved out what he has to say in his own living.
