Cafeteria Food Prices to Increase

Food prices in the Cariboo College Food Training Centre Cafeteria will increase on Monday, October 4, 1976. The average 9.5% increase is forced by the requirement that the cafeteria cover^{its} costs in food production according to Student Services Director Chuck Bishop. "We are required by the Department of Education to charge all food costs except those directly related to the training of cooking students to the cafeteria operation," he said. "The Chairman of the Food Training Centre, Ken Horlock, has tried to redesign some food items so that they represent better value," Bishop reported, "but there is no escaping the fact that prices are rising." In the past Cariboo College was able to charge more of the cost of the cafeteria operation to the training program but under present accounting guidelines this is no longer possible. "We believe that Cariboo College still provides its students with a bargain in food services," Bishop said, "but our first responsibility is to train cooks."
