Workshop for Working Women

Women in management will be the topic of a workshop scheduled for Saturday, October 18 at Cariboo College.

Entitled "Workshop for Working Women: Moving into Management" and co-sponsored by the Cariboo College Counselling Department and the Business and Professional Women's Club, the seminar is set for 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. in the college boardroom.

Participants are asked to register by calling the college's Continuing Education Department at 374-3661 by October 15. Dress should be casual and those attending should bring their own lunches.

Nadia Olafson, chief counsellor at Cariboo, said the workshop has a three-fold purpose: to present the results of a local survey by her department during the summer on opportunities for women in management; to suggest various courses and readings suitable as training for management; and, through guest speakers, to demonstrate how to go about obtaining the objective of breaking into management.

Mrs. Olafson said that hopefully the workshop will result in some specific vehicles, possibly in the form of college courses, being made available to women seeking management positions.
