Students Advised to Apply Early

July 28, 1975

Prospective Cariboo College students are being advised to apply immediately for admission to Fall 1975 courses in order to ensure themselves places in desired classes and to efficiently plan their programs.

College Principal Jack Harrison states that while classroom facilities have not increased for Fall semester, indications are that there may be a substantial increase in the number of University Transfer students wishing to attend Cariboo College.

"It is advisable to apply early as some classes may fill quickly," he stated. "Nursing and Social Work Aide classes are already filled."

Registrar Andy Wilson and Chief Counsellor Nadia Olafson also recommended early application, with counselling being a key initial step to assure good planning.

Olafson said that from one to three hours of counselling time is required to effectively plan programs for most students new to the college. "New students should therefore arrange to see one of our three counsellors by no later than the end of the first week in August."

The counselling procedure defines a student's goals and existing skills before selecting the courses best suited to the applicant.

Registration Day, September 4, will be extended into the evening to accommodate part-time students unable to attend during the morning or afternoon.
