PUBLIC LECTURES OF THE SAME MANAGEMENT

At 8 p.m., Thursday, January 9, 1975 the following lectures will be held in the Cariboo College Boardroom:

Georogy of Craigmont Copper Deposit by Gerry Sanford, Chief Geologist. Craigmont Mines Limited, Merritt, B.C. and Volcanism and Some Copper-Gold Deposits in Southern British Columbia by Dr. Peter Fox, P. Eng., Fox Geological Consultants Ltd., Kamloops, B.C.

The Craigmont copper-iron ore zone generally is considered to be of metasomatic origin. Mr. Sanford will review the geology of the mine in the light of his recent detailed studies. Dr. Fox's regional research on the relationship of volcanism, plutonism, and economic mineralization will be of special interest to all prospectors.

The talks will be followed by question-and-answer sessions. They are jointly sponsored by the British Columbia Department of Mines and Petroleum Resources and the Department of Science and Technology of Cariboo College.
