Molson's College Invitational Hockey Tournament

The organizing committee of the Molson's College Invitational Hockey Tournament are pleased to announce details on their 4th annual event, slated for February 9-12/78 in both the Sports Centre and Memorial Arena.

The committee has been working hard these past few months under the leadership of chairman, Gordon Barrett, and includes in its membership Bud Fraser, Mickey Zoyetz, Percy Mills, Fred Cunningham, Buckley Lord, Pat O'Brien, Terry Bangen, Dave Robertson, Chuck Bishop, Frank Rota, Chris Butcher and Molson's rep Pat O'Connell.

This year's line-up of teams promises to be the most prestigious of any tournament to date. Last year's championship team, Red Deer College, has confirmed their attendance. Red Deer also won the Canadian Championship last season. Anyone witnessing the final at last year's tournament will remember the exciting hockey that Red Deer provides. Other Alberta colleges include the always tough Mount Royal College of Calgary, consolation winners last year, and Southern Alberta Institute of Technology from Calgary, who won this year's Red Deer Tournament.

Ontario's entry is a new one, Canadore College of North Bay. They will be counted on to uphold the past performances of St. Clair. Northern Arizona University from Flagstaff, Arizona will provide an international flavor. NAU plays a very competitive exhibition schedule and are pre-tournament favorites along with Red Deer. Rounding out the tournament line-up are the B.C. colleges, Okanagan, Douglas, Vancouver Community and, of course, host Cariboo.

Teams still interested include Selkirk and Malaspina from B.C. and Gonzaga University from Spokane, Washington.

Draw for the 1979 Tournament will be released shortly.

Another exciting feature for this year's event is the ticket price arrangement. Day passes are available which will cover the full day's slate of games. The only exception is the final. If you want to go to 1 game or every game that day has to offer - the price is the same:
