Cariboo College Council Chairman, Don Murray, said today that the Council regarded the selection of the Principal as "the most important, single task facing Cariboo College in the foreseeable future."

Murray expressed "regret that the Cariboo College Faculty and Chairpersons and the Student Society had elected to ignore the Council's wishes by nominating single delegates to the Search Committee for the new Principal."

"It was our hope," Murray said, "that all the constituent groups in the College community would make selections which would be truly representative of the population of Cariboo College. Instead Faculty, Chairpersons and the Students have selected representatives from the academic side of the College thus ignoring two-thirds of their constituents."

"The Search Committee will proceed with its task" he stated. The Student Society, the Faculty Association and the Committee of Chairpersons have been invited to reconsider their position and to forward nominees to the Council.
