CARIBOO COLLEGE HOSTS ARCTIC EXHIBIT

From November 11 to December 15 the Library of the Kamloops campus of Cariboo College will be the scene of the National Museum exhibit "Arctic Oasis". The series of 48 excellent photographs of arctic flora and fauna is presently on display in the College during Library open hours. Dr. Mark Taylor of the Department of Physical and Life Sciences said that he was very pleased that an exhibition of this calibre was available in the Interior, and he expressed appreciation to both the National Museum in Ottawa and the Provincial Museum in Victoria for making the display possible.

"This display is only the first of a number we have planned for the next year," Taylor stated. "The Department of Physical and Life Sciences hopes to use these exhibits to bring new interpretations in science related fields to the College community and the general public."
