CARIBOO COLLEGE LIBRARY

The Cariboo College Board responded immediately to the disaster which struck the Kamloops main branch of the Cariboo Thompson Nicola Regional Library on 9 January 1979, by offering the public the use of the College library facilities.

The Board wanted to ensure that the specialized resources of the College would be available to library patrons until the Kamloops facility is back in operation, according to Acting Principal, Leo Perra.

College Librarian, David Fox, is making arrangements to extend borrowing privileges to Regional Library card-holders. The public has always had access to College Library materials, Fox pointed out, but this is the first time the service is being widely advertised.
