On Thursday, March 29, Dr. Bernard Aaronson of Vancouver will give a free public lecture in the Boardroom at 8:00 p.m. titled, "The Meaning of Myth, Dreams, and Fairy Tales." Dr. Aaronson is a well-known consulting psychologist, researcher, therapist, hypnotist, and teacher of meditation. He pioneered the use of fantasy methods in psychotherapy and is former Chief of Environmental Psychology Section at the New Jersey Bureau of Research in Neurology and Psychiatry. He is co-editor of Psychedelics: The Uses and Implications of Hallucinogen Drugs and author of a forthcoming book, Workshops of the Mind.
