CARIBOO COLLEGE APPOINTS NEW VICE-PRINCIPAL, ADMINISTRATION

Cariboo College Principal, Charles W. Brewster announced today that M. Wayne Cunningham of Barrie, Ontario, has accepted the position of Vice-Principal (Administration) at Cariboo College as of October 1, 1980. Cunningham, 46, will be replacing Leo Perra who recently resigned to accept an appointment as Principal of Selkirk College in Castlegar.

"We are very pleased", Brewster said, "that Mr. Cunningham has decided to accept our offer. His extensive background in college administration in the Alberta and Ontario systems will stand Cariboo College in good stead as it enters its second decade".

Brewster noted that most recently Cunningham has held the position of Principal at the Barrie campus of Georgian College, a multi-campus Ontario institution with branches in the Orillia, Owen Sound and Barrie areas.

"It was a tough competition", Brewster said, "with a large number of qualified people applying for the position". "I am really pleased", he added, "that the Board had such a good selection of candidates from which to choose, and I have every confidence that Mr. Cunningham will make a real contribution to the educational leadership of Cariboo College".
