Residents of the Cariboo College region have their first full-scale opportunity in five years this Saturday to see and hear what is going on in more than 60 different fields of study and training at Cariboo College.

The College's 10th Anniversary Open House, scheduled from 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. in more than a dozen different locations at the McGill Road Campus, is designed to "let the public see in detail how the College serves the community", as Principal Charles Brewster expresses it.

Visitors will be able to browse, to stroll, to ask questions of faculty and students, to watch laboratory experiments, vocational class sessions and special demonstrations, and to have their language skills, their physical fitness or their blood pressure tested.

A campus map, keyed to the individual buildings and programs, will be available to those who neglected to clip and bring the full-page announcement in the Kamloops newspapers.

The last Open House at the College was in the Spring of 1976. Since then the College has added a Gymnasium, a Library and a new ultra-modern Science Building. All buildings will be open and staffed for the displays.
