"Energy - Key to Understanding the Forces of Nature" is the title of a lecture to be given by Dr. Joseph Spuller in the board room of Cariboo College on Friday, February 28, 1986 at 7:30 p.m.

The concept of energy can provide an effective means for understanding the basic forces of nature. Two aspects of energy will be discussed: firstly, the principle of conservation of energy and secondly, the various forms of energy. These two key aspects of energy form the foundation for important insights into the behaviour of matter in general.

Dr. Spuller received his PhD from UBC for empirical studies in particle physics. He has done pure physics research in various labs around the world including the United States, Canada and Switzerland. Cariboo College is fortunate to have Dr. Spuller on staff this year as a Physics Instructor.

The 45 minute lecture, followed by a question and discussion period is open to the public. Admission is free and coffee will be served.
