On Sunday, May 18, at 2:30 p.m., Cariboo College President, Charles Brewster, will formally acknowledge the transfer of an archaeological collection to the Kamloops Indian Band.

The College placed these artifacts in trust with the Kamloops Museum and Archives in 1982 until such time as the Kamloops Indian Band had a suitable facility in which to house the collections. Former Cariboo College archeology instructor, Arnoud Stryd, was chiefly responsible for the finding, classification and coordination of the collections. When the Archaeology program at Cariboo College was discontinued five years ago, it was decided to donate the historical collections to the Kamloops Indian Band.

Museum and Archives Curator, Ken Favrholdt, said, "This is an important and unique collection and the Museum has been proud and pleased to have housed the artifacts in the transitional period".
