"New Ways of Using Your Brain" is the title of the second in the Cariboo College Public Lectures Series to be given by Peter Peters on Friday, October 17th at 7:30 p.m. in the Cariboo College Boardroom.

Peters will explain and demonstrate several new methods of thinking and using the brain which have been developed by researchers such as Edward de Bono, Roger von Oechs and Richard Bandler. Edward de Bono has developed a set of exercises which allow people to become more effective and imaginative in problem solving and decision making. Roger von Oechs has developed methods which enhance creativity while Richard Bandler has suggested new innovative ways of using one's brain more effectively.

Peters, who has taught at Cariboo College since its beginning, holds a Master's degree from the University of British Columbia. He is a practitioner of Neuro Linguistic Programming and is extremely interested in holistic education and the pursuit of excellence.
