Mel Galloway, Director of Student Services, today announced that the jointly funded federal and provincial Challenge '86 Summer Student Employment program was successfully completed at the end of August.

This year Cariboo employed 28 full-time students during the summer months. These students filled a variety of positions ranging from assisting in the Computer Aided Drafting Department to the Athletic and Horticulture Departments.

Galloway said, "It is my sense that this program has two values to students. The first is that the students find it a valuable work experience which can be listed on a resume and which is recognized in the workplace. The second reason is that, although the wage scale is the minimum wage of \$3.65 per hour which means it is usually only feasible for those students who are still living at home, it does assist with tuition fees in the following year".
