Bill Walton, Chairman of Cariboo College's Digital and Fine Art Department is pleased to announce that beginning on May 4th, the Digital Art and Design program will be offering a four-week Introduction to Digital Art course.

This month long introduction course is intended to familiarize students with the sophisticated equipment as well as to explore the features and possibilities of high technology in the production of graphics, animation and art images.

The regular one-year diploma program, one of only two in Canada's community colleges and the only such course offered west of Ontario, teaches the uses of "state of the art" computer graphics equipment. Students learn to produce complex animated video sequences and the ability to use photographic imagery with computer-generated graphics using thousands of colours, textures and type-styles; the heart of modern television advertising technology. Students learn to produce high-resolution colour stills for use in audio-visual presentation or for inclusion in high quality print publications.
