HIGHLIGHTS OF COLLEGE REPORTS
AS OUTLINED BY D. JANOWSKY AND C. BREWSTER
AT THE CARIBOO COLLEGE BOARD MEETING OF FEBRUARY 4, 1986

1. With the purchase of a building for a new campus in Williams Lake programming was expanded in that area.
2. There was an expansion of the first aid facilities.
3. Plans were approved for the third floor renovations to accommodate the Computers and Information Processing Department and these renovations are now underway.
4. Our Respiratory Therapy Graduates' marks topped the nation.
5. Cariboo College was the winner of the Totem Conference - the first time the winner has been from outside the Lower Mainland.
6. A new College logo was developed.
7. The public lecture series was well attended by the college community and the public.
8. Horticulture students did a fantastic job of grounds maintenance at the College. In addition, they held a very successful plant sale.
9. The College offered a Fitness Testing Program to its staff which was well attended.
10. The College Board instituted a deferred salary/leave plan for its staff.
11. A total of \$22,000 was offered to students through Cariboo College Foundation Scholarships.
12. A total of \$14,000 was offered in Sports Task Force Scholarships.
