The appointment of Ron Miles as Director, Arts and Humanities Division, Cariboo College, has been announced by College officials.

This appointment, effective September 1, completes the roster of directors for the College's newly-established four instructional divisions. The other three were announced earlier this week.

Miles, an instructor at the College since its founding in 1970, has previously served as chairperson of the English Department (1975 - 1981). He is widely known in the Kamloops area as an organizer and administrator in the performing arts field, especially through his leadership in the College's Cultural Events Committee and Film Society. He has also been active province-wide both in that field and in the coordination of post-secondary English studies.

A specialist in Canadian Literature and in creative writing (poetry and drama), Miles is the author of more than 100 poems published in Canadian and American magazines.

As Director of the Arts and Humanities Division, he will have overall responsibility for all courses and programs in Social Sciences, Human Services, Communication Arts and Fine and Applied Arts.

The other three directors assuming responsibility for their respective divisions are Dr. David Cane, Science and Health Sciences; Benjamin L. Eldridge, Vocational and Industrial; and Richard M. Olesen, Business and Mathematics.
