Nelson Riis, MP for Kamloops-Shuswap, is giving a talk in the Cariboo College Boardroom entitled "Talking Tory, or, the Right is Right". The fifth lecture in the Academic Lecture Series takes place on Friday, February 22 at 7:30 p.m.

Nelson Riis will discuss the conservative agenda for the Western Economies with special focus on Canadian society and politics.

During the last decade a decided shift in values has occurred in western society. The elected governments, especially those of Great Britain and the United States, have introduced new economic and social policies. The economic policies have focussed money on a reduction in inflation rather than unemployment. In addition, there has been an effort to reduce government involvement in the economy and to return the operation of the economy to free enterprise. The social policies have generally led to a reduction in social welfare services. Interest rates have been kept high and government deficits have been condemned.

Nelson Riis, who taught at Cariboo College for several years, will consider these topics from his experience as a parliamentarian. Coffee will be served after the talk and before the question and discussion period. Free admission.
