Cariboo College is pleased to announce that Philosophy will be offered at the College for the first time, beginning in September.

In the fall semester, "Introduction to Critical Thinking" will be offered Wednesday evenings beginning September 11. This course is a first course in logic, and will be of value to anyone engaged in university studies and also general interest students wishing to develop skills of clear thinking and rational argumentation.

Present day controversial issues will be used in the course to illustrate the techniques of determining the validity and soundness of arguments.

This course will be followed in the winter semester by "Introduction to Philosophical Concepts" which surveys a number of important classical philosophers.

The instructor for the courses, Daniel O'Reilly, is a Ph.D candidate in Philosophy at UBC and also teaches computing at the College.

The College will be applying for university transfer credit for these new courses shortly.
