Cariboo College received formal approval today to proceed with the purchase and renovation of the former Utratherm Canada building on Highway 97, Williams Lake at an estimated cost of \$1,200,000.

In commenting on the approval, College Board Chairman Dale Janowsky stated: "The Board is obviously pleased with the announcement. It reaffirms our decision earlier this year to consolidate our operations in the City of Williams Lake and at the same time improve our educational services for the area residents".

Janowsky noted that the funding was not an allocation of incrementally new dollars. "As a part of our planning process," he said, "we made a comprehensive review of the leases and rentals for our Williams Lake operation. We then decided it would be more economically advantageous to consolidate our programming in one facility rather than being located around town".

"By re-assigning some of our educational programs," he added, "we will also be able to offer more training in Williams Lake than we had previously done".

The College expects to complete the renovations to the Ultratherm building over the next few months with occupancy targetted for January 1, 1986.
