FINANCIAL SURVIVAL COURSE

A course that will teach Canadians how to survive financially in these times of inflation, recession and fluctuating interest rates is sponsored by Cariboo College this winter.

The course in family and financial planning was developed by the Canadian Life and Health Insurance Association and is being offered as a public service to universities and community colleges across Canada.

John Carpenter, Vice-President of London Life and Chairman of the sub-committee that worked on developing the course, said this is the first time the private sector has developed a comprehensive program on personal and financial planning.

Carpenter said "we think it is to everybody's advantage to have a more informed public that can recognize its needs and the choices that are available to satisfy those needs."
