**JIM BOREN: PRESIDENT OF THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF**

Boren went to Washington, D.C. to head the staff of a U.S. Senator. He later served for nine years as a senior foreign service officer in Latin America where he received numerous awards for his work. In 1968 he founded the International Association of Professional Bureaucrats to combat the excesses and deficiencies of bureaucracy. Boren holds 5 degrees including a Ph.D. from the University of Texas.

Mr. Boren is on a speaking tour across Canada to the Canadian and Information Processing Society (CIPS) chapters. The Kamloops Section has the pleasure of sponsoring Mr. Boren at its regular monthly dinner meeting on Monday, December 9th.
