Starting September 9, Cariboo College will offer Anthropology 223, Indians of British Columbia 2, in the College's Merritt Learning Centre.

This second year university transfer course covers B.C.'s traditional native cultures, with special emphasis on the southern interior. Topics to be studied include social and political organization, settlement patterns, warfare, trade, religion and ceremonialism.

Instructor Bob Muckle is an archaeologist specializing in B.C. native Indian culture, tradition and history. He works with many Indian bands and other groups concerned with B.C. before white contact, and has taught for Simon Fraser University, Cariboo College and the Vancouver School Board.

Anthropology 223 is a three credit Cariboo College course, transferable to the University of British Columbia, Simon Fraser University and the University of Victoria. Classes are scheduled Wednesday evenings, from September 9th to December 9th. The cost to students is \$69 tuition, plus textbooks.
