

## ACCOMMODATION

Homestay and campus residences are available. Further information and applications for homestay or residence will be supplied upon request. Students may make independent arrangements for other rental accommodation if desired.

## TUITION FEES

Valid for the period of April 1, 1992 to March 31, 1993

The basic tuition fee is CDN \$5,500 per semester. The Applied Business Program consists of two (2) semesters per year.

*Additional Fee: Students taking the Enriched Program are required to pay additional fees over and above the basic Tuition Fee. The Additional Fee will be calculated on the basis of additional time and material spent to assist students in the development and implementation of their own individual business projects as well as individual student's requirements.*

## COMMENCEMENT OF STUDIES

Semesters commence in September, January and May for College Preparation and English As A Second Language. Applied Business program commences in September 1992. UCC students should allow at least three months for processing and acquisition of a student authorization for study at the University College of the Cariboo.

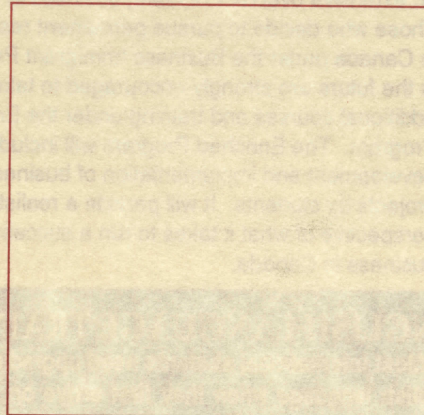

# P R O G R A M S O F S T U D Y

## ■ ■ ■ ■ ■ SOUTHGATE APPLIED BUSINESS INSTITUTE

The University College of the Cariboo in partnership with Southgate Trade & Technology Centre Inc. has created a new Applied Business Diploma Program. This is a unique partnership and a new program. This program brings together a private business incubation centre with a public University College. It is believed to be the first of its kind in Canada.

This is a unique program concept: The training will be delivered in the Southgate Trade & Technology Centre and the University campus. This will provide easy access to applied business training and direct contact with other businesses and organizations using the Centre.

## ■ ■ ■ ■ ■ DIPLOMA OF APPLIED BUSINESS

Students in this program will learn how businesses are operated in Canada. This knowledge can assist someone starting new ventures within

the Canadian context. The three-year program will focus on the following:

- academic preparation
- cultural studies
- hands-on Canadian business experience
- practical legal aspects
- import/export procedure and policy
- many other items of importance

## ■ CANADIAN EMPLOYMENT AUTHORIZATION (WORK PERMIT)

The Institute will assist students to obtain a one-year Employment Authorization (Work Permit) issued by Employment and Immigration Canada. This is intended to enable students to acquire experience outside the classroom and to help broaden the student's knowledge and appreciation of Canada's Industrial and Technological capacity.

## ■ IMMIGRATION STATUS

International students must first obtain a student authorization (student visa) to join the program. Students taking this program who may be interested in applying for permanent residence status in Canada can do so at any time during their involvement in the program. The Business Immigrant categories are: Investor, Entrepreneur and Self-Employment.

## ■ WHO SHOULD TAKE THIS PROGRAM:

This program is designed for students, business people, entrepreneurs and investors from outside Canada. The primary purpose of this program is to offer potential business immigrants the best possible chance to succeed. The new entrepreneur's chance of success is often related to his or her knowledge of doing business in Canada and the ability to follow the established procedures and make the required adjustments.

## ■ ENRICHED PROGRAM

The Diploma of Applied Business program provides an extensive overview of doing business in Canada. Those who decide to pursue permanent residence in Canada under the Business Immigrant Program in the future are strongly encouraged to take additional courses and training under the Enriched Program. The Enriched Program will include the development and implementation of business projects by students. It will provide a realistic perspective of what it takes to run a successful business in Canada.

## ENGLISH LANGUAGE TRAINING

Most international students need upgrading in the English language when they first arrive on campus. For this reason, a full range of courses in English is available. Students are given an extensive test after they arrive and are then assigned to necessary upgrading course.

Until students are sufficiently competent in English, their English upgrading courses take precedence over all other work. At the discretion of the institution, students are permitted to combine English with other course work if possible.

## ■ ■ ■ ■ ■ ADDITIONAL COURSES

Students may take additional credit courses equivalent to the first two years of university level study. This option is subject to the availability of courses and the eligibility of the students. Upon graduation from this program, students who have sufficient credits and satisfy entry requirements, may continue to complete one of the following degrees:

- Bachelor of Science - *granted by UBC*
- Bachelor of Business Administration - *granted by Simon Fraser University*
- Bachelor of Arts - *granted by UBC*
- Bachelor of Education (Elementary) - *granted by UBC*
- Bachelor of Social Work - *granted by UVic*
- Bachelor of Science in Nursing - *granted by UVic*

## ■ ■ ■ ■ ■ GENERAL INFORMATION

### Admission Requirements

All applications will be considered on an individual basis. This program is open to mature students, entrepreneurs and experienced business persons.

### Age

Students must be at least 21 years of age upon arrival on campus. Exceptions will be granted only under special circumstances. No maximum age limit.

### TOEFL

The University does not require TOEFL scores for admission, but English language upgrading is absolutely mandatory if testing indicates it to be necessary. (see "English Language Training" section.)

### Insurance

Medical insurance is mandatory. A special plan has been arranged by UCC at a cost of approximately \$430.00 Cdn for the first year. It must be purchased immediately upon arrival on campus.
