GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- Successful completion of the Business Studies Degree program requires a minimum of 120 Cariboo College credit hours of course work, with:
- A minimum CGPA of 2.0 overall
 - A minimum CGPA in Business Studies courses of 2.0
 - A minimum of 45 credits in upper division course work, including a minimum of 36 credits in Business Studies.

APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

Application is made to the Admissions Office at Cariboo College.

Documentation required includes official transcripts of previous secondary and post-secondary educational records, and proof of citizenship or Landed Immigrant status if not born

in Canada, or valid student permit.

The deadline for application is April 15th. It is recommended that the application and related documentation be submitted as soon as possible. If applicants have not yet completed all course requirements, the minimum documentation must include:

- Completed 'Application for Admission' form
- \$15.00 Application Processing Fee (only for students who have never attended Cariboo College before)
- Copy of official interim or final grades

TRANSFER STUDENTS

Students who have attended or completed their first two years at another public college or provincial university are accepted on the same basis as students attending Cariboo College.

EDUCATIONAL COSTS

Tuition fees at Cariboo College are less than those at provincial universities. A generally lower cost of living in the Interior means further savings in the overall cost of post-secondary education.

Estimated annual expenses at Cariboo College for 1991/1992:

- Tuition: lower level study \$30.50 per credit to a \$457.50 maximum per semester
- Tuition: upper level study \$47.00 per credit to a \$705.00 maximum per semester
- Student fees \$36.00
- Books and supplies \$50.00 to \$75.00 per course
- Other fees approximately \$60.00
- On-campus housing \$285.00 per month (1990/91 rate)

REGISTRATION

Registration will take place between June 3 and July 31, based on year level and date of COMPLETED application. In order to register, students will be required to pay a maximum \$200.00 non-refundable "commitment fee" which will apply towards the first semester's tuition fees.

Cariboo College makes available, through the College Foundation, a limited number of entrance scholarships for students entering this degree program. Further information is available through the Financial Aid and Awards Office.

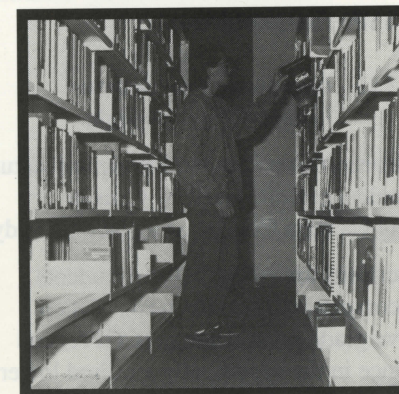

BACHELOR OF BUSINESS STUDIES – SFU

Cariboo College offers a Bachelor’s Degree in Business Studies conferred by Simon Fraser University (SFU). This degree provides students with a broadly based education in the Humanities, Social Sciences, Mathematics, and Sciences in the first two years, and a choice of three Business concentrations over the final two years of upper level study: General Business, Human Resource Management, and Marketing.



Admission to the program is at the third year level, after students have completed general education and lower level requirements. Once admitted to the program, students are expected to complete the degree at Cariboo College.

Students may apply early for admission to the degree program after completion of 45 credit hours and with 15 credit hours in progress, and may be admitted with as little as 54 credit hours if all core and prerequisite course requirements have been met and a reasonable course plan for third year can be developed. Attainment of the minimum prescribed requirements means only that the applicant is eligible for selection and does not provide assurance of admission.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Successful completion of at least 54 credits of lower level work, including the following courses with at least a C grade:
Any ECON 100-level course
ECON 211 Principles of Macroeconomics
ECON 221 Principles of Microeconomics
MATH 140 Calculus for Commerce and the Social Sciences 1
MATH 141 Calculus for Commerce and the Social Sciences 2
COMM 221 Financial Accounting 1
BBUS 232 Economic and Business Statistics 1
BBUS 237 Introduction to Computers and Information Systems in Business
PHIL 111 Introduction to Critical Thinking
ENGL 110 Composition
or
ENGL 111 Introduction to Modern Literature and Thought
 - Canadian citizenship, Landed Immigrant status, or a valid student permit issued by Canada (indicating Cariboo College as a place of study).
- All applications are evaluated and students selected competitively on the basis of their cumulative grade point average (CGPA) and performance in the specifically required lower level courses.



UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Lower Division Requirements: First and Second Year

Students will normally complete the following requirements in first and second year prior to admission to the BBS program:

- The specific course requirements listed above
- A minimum of 12 credits in courses from at least two disciplines in the Humanities (ENGL 111 and PHIL 111 count toward this requirement, ENGL 110 does not.)
- A minimum of 12 credits in courses from at least two disciplines in the Social Sciences (All ECON courses satisfy this requirement.)
- A minimum of 6 credits in courses in the Sciences and Mathematics (MATH 140 and MATH 141 count toward this requirement.)
- An additional 20 credits for a minimum total of 50 credits outside Business Studies (ie. excluding BBUS and COMM courses)

Upper Division Requirements: Third and Fourth Year

Students are not permitted to take Upper Division (300- and 400-level) Business Studies courses during their first 60 credits unless they have written permission from the degree Program Advisor.
