KAMLOOPS—Aboriginal culture and diversity will be front-and-centre during First Nations Awareness Week at UCC March 11 to 15.

The annual event welcomes the UCC community and the general public to a venue that highlights local First Nations arts, entertainment, recreation and other traditional pastimes.

"We are focusing on Shuswap First Nations culture and also highlighting the diverse culture that exists at UCC through students coming here from outside this area," said Fred Allison, First Nations Awareness Week co-ordinator. "Creating unity is our main theme."

There are about 600 First Nations students attending UCC, from B.C., Alberta, Saskatchewan and as far away as Nunavut.
