#### **Introduction:**

With a focus on Targets 3.5: Strengthen the prevention and treatment of substance abuse, including narcotic drug abuse and harmful use of alcohol; 3.5.1: Coverage of treatment interventions (pharmacological, psychosocial and rehabilitation and aftercare services) for substance use disorders; 3.5.2: Harmful use of alcohol, defined according to the national context as alcohol per capita consumption (aged 15 years and older) within a calendar year in litres of pure alcohol.

Steps for your infographic:

Read the above article.

Choose only ONE infographic platform Canva, Infogr.am, Easelly, Piktochart, and Visme. If you have another platform in mind please use wherever you are most comfortable with.

Mention the specific Psychedelic you did research on.

Give an overview definition of the Psychedelic

Tell the history of the psychedelic: what religion/ culture is associate it with (it could be multiple), how it is used religiously, the oldest records on it etc.

How can the Psychedelic connect to the bellow subgoals of UNSDG #3:

- 3.5 Strengthen the prevention and treatment of substance abuse, including narcotic drug abuse and harmful use of alcohol
- 3.5.1 Coverage of treatment interventions (pharmacological, psychosocial and rehabilitation and aftercare services) for substance use disorders
- 3.5.2 Harmful use of alcohol, defined according to the national context as alcohol per capita consumption (aged 15 years and older) within a calendar year in litres of pure alcohol
